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Lodge Officer Descriptions on Back

Lodge Chief – Serves as the youth leader of the lodge and represents Aracoma at section, region, and national events. The Lodge Chief serves as chairman of all Lodge Executive Committee meetings and meetings of the lodge. He should be familiar with the Lodge Rules and Procedures, as well as Robert's Rules of Order. The Lodge Chief works in close consultation with the adult advisers and other lodge officers to ensure that all aspects of the lodge are functioning as they should. He is responsible for appointing committee chairmen. The Lodge Chief is expected to be in attendance at all LECs, lodge functions, and at other events where Aracoma needs representation (e.g. section Council of Chiefs).

Vice Chief of Administration – First in line of succession in the event of a vacancy in the position of Lodge Chief, so should be familiar with and ready to serve in that role. Serves in the Lodge Chief's place when the Lodge Chief is unable to be present or perform his duties. Responsible for overseeing and facilitating the OA Troop Representative program throughout the Black Warrior Council. Is expected to be in regular attendance of all functions of the lodge.

Vice Chief of Program – Responsible for the overall scheduling, planning, and promotion of lodge events and functions. Oversees committees for special events such as Conclave or NOAC. Is expected to be in regular attendance of all functions of the lodge.

Vice Chief of Inductions – Coordinates and oversees the processes of Unit Elections through the Brotherhood Ceremony. Ensures that elections are held correctly and on time, call-out ceremonies are coordinated, the Ordeal experience is positive, and encourages members to attain Brotherhood membership. Is expected to be in regular attendance of all functions of the lodge.

Secretary/Treasurer – Responsible for maintaining records of the lodge, of LEC proceedings, and finances. Publishes the lodge newsletter and oversees the lodge website, social media, and other forms of communicating with the lodge. Is expected to be in regular attendance of all functions of the lodge.
